Who can grow the tallest sunflower?

When to sow:
April - May

Where to sow:
Straight into the soil about 3cm deep. Soak the soil with water as soon as you have sown the seeds. Seedlings should appear about two to three weeks later. You can also sow the seeds in little pots of compost (recycle a yogurt pot) and plant them out in the garden, or into a bigger pot, when they are a few centimetres high.

Flowering time:
July - October

When the plants have finished flowering, leave them in the garden as the seed heads make great bird feeders
