Flu Vaccines

A polite reminder that the Immunisation team will be in school on Thursday 28th September. If you haven't don't so already, please can you open the attached document in the Spider app in order to use their e-consent form.

The letter has a link for you to follow which then gives you information about the vaccination programme and allows you to give electronic consent. Each school has a unique identifying number for the e consent system, our schools number is also contained in this letter.

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As in previous years, our Year 4, 5 & 6 pupils are invited to attend the Walton Gardens Cross Country Competition. There are three dates for children to attend, please note these in your diary:

It would be fantastic if we could have as many children attending as possible to ensure we are able to maintain the achievements set in previous years. Please note your child does not have to attend the school running club to represent the school, they are welcome to run if they would like too. The Walton Gardens event is an extremely well organised event with many schools across Warrington in attendance. All children who attend enjoy the experience to represent the school and be a part of a team, as well as compete for individual awards.

Children should aim to attend all three races if possible. If they are unable to attend all, they should on the dates they are able to.

The race start times and distances are:

10.30 Years 4 & 5 Girls 1.4k (1 Lap) 10.50 Years 4 & 5 Boys 1.4k (1 Lap) 11.10 Year 6 Girls 2k (1 Loop + 1 Lap) 11.30 Year 6 Boys 2k (1 Loop + 1 Lap)

Please complete the form below and read the instructions carefully if your child is able to race on the Saturday 30th September

The first race is on the 30th of September, Runners are to meet Miss Lambert at 10.00am outside the café entrance. Please ensure prompt arrival so the children can warm up appropriately prior to racing.

Please ensure your child is wearing their school PE

top and is dressed appropriately for the weather on the day as the races will be run regardless of wind, rain or snow. Miss Lambert will provide children running with a vest to race in, this can be worn over your child's white PE top if preferred. Please note that a Parent/Guardian has to attend with each runner and will be their responsibility during the event.

Warrington Athletics Club have issued a reminder that all school representatives (including parents) and spectators to keep off the course once the first race has started. There are walkways around the course that can be accessed at all times. No one should be crossing the tape at any point during the races.

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
