Dear Parents and Carers,

This Sunday marks the final week in the Church's calendar, with the feast of Christ the King, or 'Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe'.

In our Gospel assembly this week the children spent time wondering about Kingship, and shared questions and thoughts about the type of king Jesus was and is to us. As we come to the end of another Church year, it is a time to reflect and get ready for the season of Advent ahead of us. Pope Francis has declared the new liturgical year, which begins on the First Sunday of Advent, a *Year of Prayer*.

'I would greatly desire that we devote 2024, the year preceding the Jubilee event, to a great "symphony" of prayer. Prayer, above all else, to renew our desire to be in the presence of the Lord, to listen to him and to adore him.' Pope Francis

2025 is a Jubilee year for the Church, and I will share more on that in future newsletters. For now it is enough to focus on the Pope's desire for us to consider prayer, and to make space and room for prayer in our lives.

Mini Police



This academic year St Monica's will be joining with a number of schools across Warrington, taking part in a scheme run by Cheshire Constabulary called the "Mini Police". Our Mini Police officers will be working with the Senior Leadership Team and our local PCSOs to work on projects which come out of issues they have identified for our local community. We have a team of ten pupils from Years 4,5 and 6 who will become mini police officers for this year. We were overwhelmed with the interest in this new group, and had a total of 20 applications for the 10 positions. All of the applicants went on to have an interview with the leadership team. Miss Williams and I were extremely proud of every single applicant. Applications and interviews are a life skill, and I have told all the children in assembly today that every applicant has been successful, in that they have put themselves out of their comfort zone and gained valuable experience that will stand them in good stead the next time an opportunity comes up, or an interview is required.

Our Mini Police officers have been invited to a ceremony next Wednesday morning, where they will be 'sworn in', and all the officers will receive a mini police officer uniform to wear during that event, but also when conducting MPO activities. I look forward to seeing the ideas the group come up with for making improvements on issues in our local area.


