Dear Parents and Carers,

It has been a cold one this week, but we are glad for a pause in the rain!

This week the staff have begun our OPAL (outdoor play and learning) journey, with a whole staff training session, and the first strategy meeting where we audited our current play provision. Our OPAL mentor, Beth, spent lunchtime with the children yesterday and she was very complimentary about them saying how friendly, caring and fun their play was. The children have lots of ideas of what they would like to see improved in their play experience, and we will be working closely with them through the process. As this is a strategic change in the way we look at and provide for play experiences, it is a journey of 18-24months to become established. We are in the process of setting up the OPAL Working Party group, and beginning on our first step establishing our policy for play. It is an exciting journey to be on, and one which we know will support all children in school in having the best play experiences they can. Watch this space for OPAL news, which we will put out regularly so that you are kept abreast of where we are up to, what help we need, donation requests and good news stories from the children.
